Every exhibiting artist in the Recovered Futures Art Exhibition has lived mental health experience, either through their own direct personal experience or in their role as a carer or family member. Each artwork sold delivers 85 per cent of the proceeds directly to the artist and in 2023, sales exceeded \$77,000.


